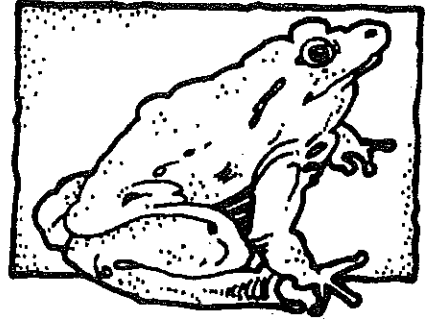

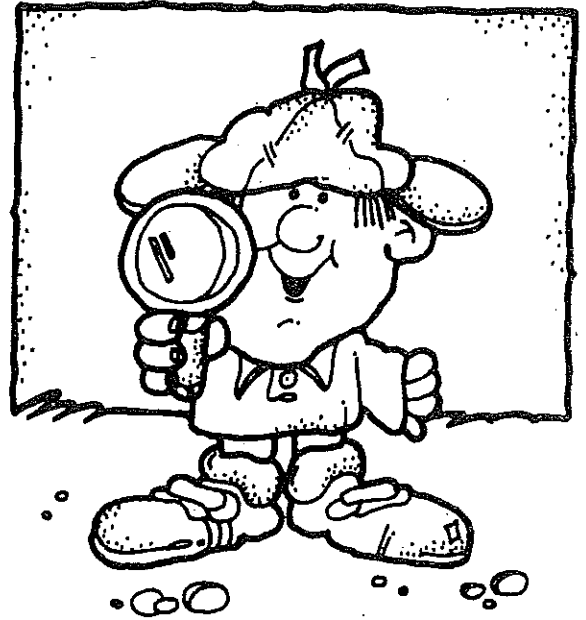

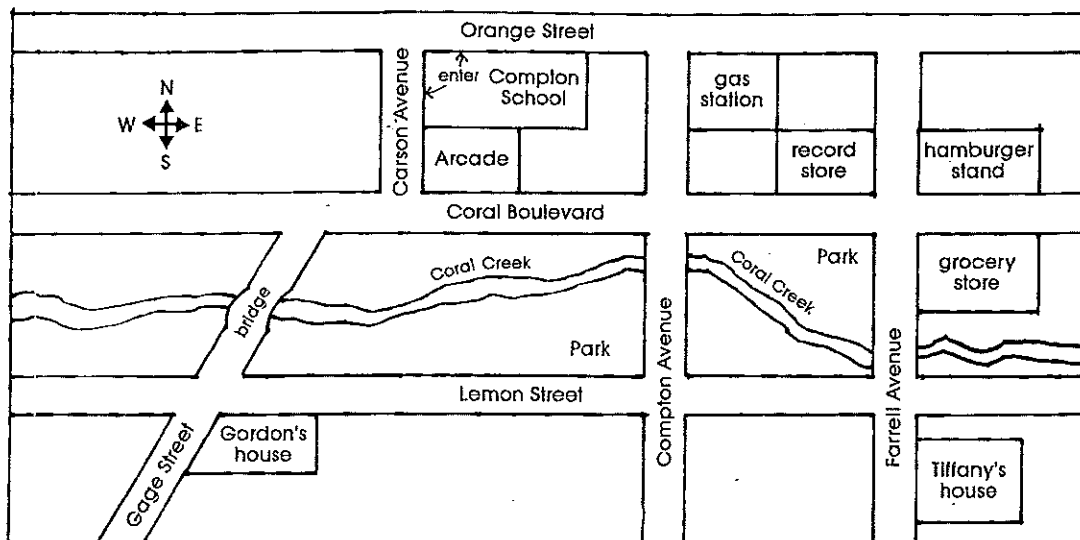

Tiffany's Directions

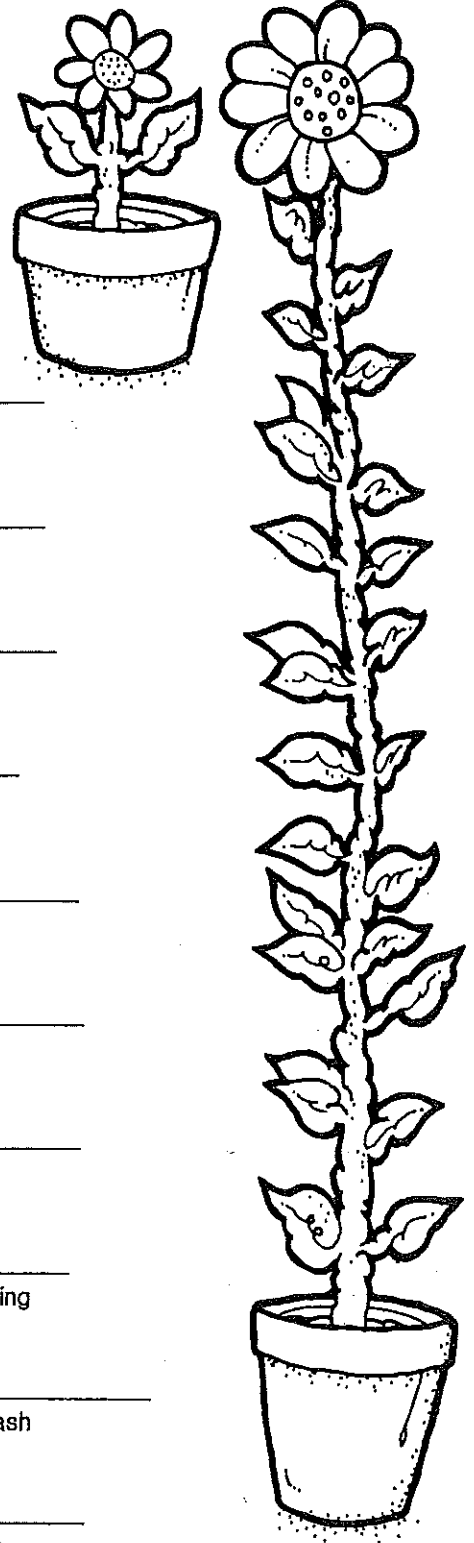
- 3 Walk north on Compton Avenue until you get to the gas station.
